

Medicaid Incarceration Application Quick Reference Guide

Expedited Application (emergency application) - An incarcerated individual not enrolled in Medicaid with an unforeseen and imminent hospital stay; OR has an upcoming hospital release or discharge. Expedited applications are reviewed within two business days. If all information is available a decision will be made or a request for information sent.

o How to guide:

➤ Call the CVIU Helpline and inform the CSR that you are calling to submit an expedited application. The applicant must be present to give a verbal signature.

New Application - An incarcerated individual not enrolled in Medicaid and without a release date within the next 45 days. (*If releasing within 45 days refer to Re-Entry.*)

o How to guide:

- ➤ Call the CVIU Helpline to submit an application.
- > The facility Point of Contact should be prepared to submit the application with the incarcerated individual. The applicant must be present to give a verbal signature.

Re-entry Application - An incarcerated individual who is: (1) Not currently enrolled in Medicaid; and (2) scheduled to be released within 45-days of the Medicaid Application Date (*The date the application was submitted and signed.*)

o How to guide:

- Call the CVIU Helpline to submit an application within 45-days of release.
- The facility Point of Contact should be prepared to submit the application with the incarcerated individual. The applicant must be present to give a verbal signature.

Pre-Release — An individual with active Medicaid of AC108, AC109, AC112 or AC113 who is scheduled to be released within 45-days.

o How to guide:

- ➤ Download and complete the <u>CVIU Communication Form</u> at <u>Cover Virginia Incarcerated Unit (CVIU)</u> Cover Virginia
- Email the communication form to CVIU (covervadmas.virginia.gov) within 45-days of the release date.

Renewal Application - Definition: An annual review application for continued coverage of Medicaid eligibility.

o How to guide:

- ➤ If Aged, Blind, or Disabled including all those eligible for Medicare, call the CVIU Helpline to submit a renewal application for incarcerated individuals due for renewal.
- ➤ The facility Point of Contact should be prepared to submit the application with the incarcerated individual. The applicant must be present to give a verbal signature.
